Stoney is a professional artist with over 20 years experience. She provides expert leadership and individual support, both in honing old skills and techniques and teaching new ones. Stoney is passionate about colour and design and helping students express themselves creatively in a variety of mediums. She has run many successful workshops including ones at West Dean, Skyros in Greece, and the Moray Arts Centre in Scotland. Amongst her many commissioned works are pieces at Raymond Blanc's 'Le Manoir aux Quat' Saisons' and St. Mary's Hospital, Paddington.

The course includes:

- **Inspirational field trips** to picturesque hill top villages and market towns, taking in the stunning mountain scenery with its tumbling streams and waterfalls.
- **Morning sessions** with Stoney and time to pursue your own work in the afternoon, either on the terrace, by the pool, the meadow garden or around the village (a ruined castle and hill top church are both in easy walking distance).
- **Presentations and discussions** of different techniques including watercolour, acrylics, ink, collage, photography and found objects.
